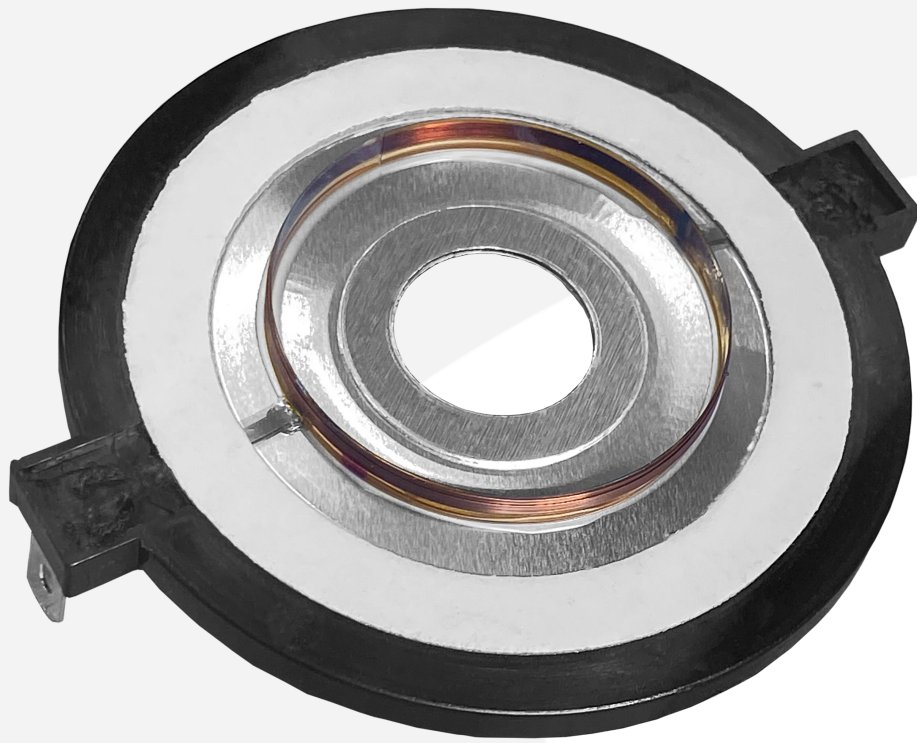

In order to recone the tweeter simply remove the sticker from the screw head in the centre of the magnet at the rear, then unscrew the allen bolt. This will allow the tweeter to come apart and the replacement diaphragm can be inserted.
